## **Scripture Text: Hosea 6:1-3**

"Come, and let us return to the LORD; For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up. After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight. Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth." (New King James Version)

"The people say, "Let's return to the LORD! He has hurt us, but he will be sure to heal us; he has wounded us, but he will bandage our wounds, won't he? In two or three days he will revive us, and we will live in his presence. Let us try to know the LORD. He will come to us as surely as the day dawns, as surely as the spring rains fall upon the earth."" (Good News Bible)

One of the key words/phrases of our scripture text is heeding the call or invitation to return to God. In life, we are bombarded with invitations or calls to one thing or another. Our response to those invitations usually is indicative of what will ultimately become of us.
