- **A.** Based on the scriptures below, please complete the following statements about 'dead works': A dead work is:
 - Romans 7:5 <u>living according to the dictates of the sinful nature</u>
 - 2 Timothy 3:5 having the form of godliness with no corresponding power; that is, RELIGIOUS FORMALISM
 - 1 Timothy 5:6; Luke 8:14; 1 John 2:15-17 seeking worldly pleasures
 - 2 Samuel 7:1-17 anything that is not approved by God
 - Acts 5:1-10 anything that is done with wrong motives
 - Matthew 7:21-23 doing things that seem good, but which are not in obedience to God
 - Matthew 6:1 doing good deed to be seen of men
 - Revelation 3:1 living on the reputation of man, apart from God
 - Revelation 2:20 following teachings that lead to sinful and disobedient living
 - Revelation 3:15-16 not living a loyal or devoted life wholly to God
- **B.** Dead works can be categorized into two (2) broad categories. Using the scriptures below, state these two broad categories.
 - Romans 8:9; Galatians 5:19-21; 1 John 3:8 Things done by someone in whom is not the Spirit of God; that is, someone who is not born again
 - Revelation 3:1-2 Things done by someone who is born again, but that fall short of God's standard
- C. In spite of the fact that dead works would naturally have been more associated with those who are not born again, we find that many so-called born again individuals are engaging in dead works. Romans 8:5-9; Proverbs 16:25; James 1:13-15; Galatians 5:16; Matthew 6:1.

- They are mindful or concerned with things of the flesh CARNALITY
- They think that their own way of doing things is the right way
- They are being directed by the lusts in them
- They are led by the flesh or the old sinful nature
- They want to look good before men
- They have not been sanctified by the Holy Spirit
- They do not ask God for direction before doing anything
- They are not living by faith
- They prefer their way to God's way

The way out of dead works is <u>repentance</u>; which implies that you <u>realize and acknowledge</u> <u>that you have been engaging in dead works, and confess these acts before God. It also</u> <u>requires that you change and begin to do good works henceforth.</u>
