- [A] Using the scripture references provided, please state whether or not the statements below are true or false.
  - (1) Faith comes by the hearing of the word of God which is preached. (**Romans 10:17**) **TRUE**
  - (2) Faith is something that you have to focus on to have. (Ephesians 2:8-9) FALSE

  - 4) Matthew 17:19-21; Jude 20. Praying in the Holy Ghost, with fasting
  - 5) **1 John 1:1-3; Hebrews 10:25.** *Having fellowship with those who have first-hand experience with God*
  - 6) **Hebrews 11:6b; John 4:19-22.** *Knowing God in an intimate way through personal encounters with Him*
