- 2. What is, and what is not, the origin of marriage? (Genesis 2:18; Matthew 19:7-8; 15:3)
 - Marriage originated from the beginning, after God had made man.
 - Moses did not originate marriage;
 - The religious leaders did not originate marriage;
 - The elders did not originate marriage;
 - Society did not originate marriage.
- **3.** Following from Nos. 1 & 2 above, where should we then turn to in order to obtain the truth about marriage? And where should we avoid turning to for counsel on marriage? (Matthew 15:3, 9; Mark 10:2-9; Psalm 1:1-2)
 - We must turn to God and His word to obtain the uncomprising truth about marriage.
 - We must turn away from:
 - > Commandments of men
 - > Compromised doctrines
 - > Self-acclaimed religious leaders
 - > The counsel of the ungodly and ungodly counsel
 - > The idea of sinners and the world
 - > The suggestion of scorners and Satan
- 4. What makes a true marriage? (Genesis 2:24-25; 1 Corinthians 6:16; Romans 7:1-4; Matthew 19:3-9)
 - God initiates it
 - It must be between a man and a woman (usually brought by God)
 - There must be a leaving of all other relationships
 - There must be a cleaving (which is a process of two becoming one in unity)
 - There must be openness (trust) between both the man and his wife
 - There must be a consummation
 - There can be no divorce. The only way they can be separated, is by the death of one of the Parties
 - There can be no room for the hardness of heart (there has to be lots of tolerance among the two Parties)
