Solution to Study 0091

- 1. Who is a Christian?
 - A Christian is a disciple or follower of the teachings and lifestyle of Jesus Christ (Acts 11:26; John 8:31); one who has already been washed, justified, and sanctified (1 Corinthians 6:9-11); and, is led by the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:5-14; Galatians 5:16-25).
- 2. What is the Marketplace?
 - It is any place where we interact with people; men and women of all works of life and persuasions (**John 17:15-16**). It is the place of concourse or the gathering of people in a public place (**Proverbs 1:20-21**). When strictly applied, the Marketplace excludes the Church—a gathering of those who believe in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour—or the Lord's vineyard (**Matthew 20:1-7; 21:12-13**).
- 3. What principles should govern a Christian in the Marketplace or how should a Christian conduct himself/herself in the Marketplace?

 A Christian's primary focus in the Marketplace is to seek to please and glorify God, by doing His will, which is achievable only when the Christian yields himself/herself completely to the Holy Spirit, and allows Him to live in, and through the Christian (1 Corinthians 6:12-20; 7:23; 2 Corinthians 5:15; 1 Corinthians 10:31; Matthew 15:13-16).
